Work is typically performed in the traditional setting of athletics (on-site, indoors/ outdoors, at multiple athletic sites) as well as a rehab/clinical environment.

To be successful in this position the ideal candidate will have the ability to perform the following functions regarding athletic injuries: prevention, assessment, treatment, (including first aide), and reconditioning as set forth by the National Athletic Trainers' Association (NATA) Board of certification. A professional/personal interest in strength and conditioning is preferred. Demonstrate proper taping, bracing, and fitting of athletic equipment is required. Demonstrate the ability to carry out all prescribed treatments and recommendations by the team/program/event/family/treating physician. Demonstrate the ability to cover assigned pre-season physicals, games, matches, community events, and related events.

A Bachelors Degree in Exercise Science or related field is required, Masters Degree and/or CSCS, ACSM or similar certifications are preferred. Must be NATA certified and possess or be in the process of acquiring licensure, certification or registration from the state of Pennsylvania. Must be BLS CPR-AED certified.
